PL Day Update

Staff at Glenbow worked on a variety of initiatives during the recent PL Day. This included working on a student friendly matrix for our Positive Behaviour and Intervention Support work. This will assist in creating common expectations for the school. Staff also spent time reviewing their classes and identifying the class strengths, areas of need and types of support that would be beneficial. Teachers will present their work at a meeting with Administration and Learning Support. Lastly, staff worked together to review some of the new curriculum and to do some collaborative planning.

School Workbook

Work has begun on the 2022-23 School Workbook. Staff, students and parents have been surveyed to provide some insights into what is going well and what could be worked on. The Rockyview School Survey and Alberta Assurance Survey data has been reviewed and goals are being set for this school year. Staff will be developing prototype projects to work on in the areas of Instructional Design, Student Engagement, Inclusion and Making Learning Visible. The workbook will be developed throughout the year.

Glenbow will be certified as an Ecoschool this year. We will be working on developing our digital literacy skills this year by participating in a number of projects.
