Message from School Council Chair, Amanda Heninger

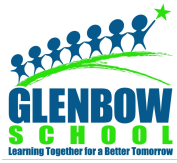
It has been a privilege to serve as this year’s school council chair for Glenbow School. This year we welcomed a new Principal and Assistant Principal who have been amazing to work with. As a school council we have been able to work together with our school administration, our fund raising society, teachers, parents and our Division Trustee to help the students at Glenbow receive the best possible educational experience. We are very grateful to all who have a hand in helping our children learn and grow.

Recent Achievements

This year has been an exciting one for our school council. Despite the challenges that COVID-19 restrictions presented we were able to host two parent workshops. The first was virtual in October featuring our Assistant Principal, Cindy Stefanato, who taught parents about the history of the Indigenous Peoples in our area. Our second was held in person in March featuring representatives from Stepping Stones for Mental Health who taught attendees about Parent/Student Mental Health. Both evenings were very well received and served to bring our school community closer together.

As a council we were able to use our School Council Engagement Grant and work together with the Learning Support staff and create a Lending Library of materials for parents who have children with developmental, learning and/or social/emotional challenges. These materials will allow parents to directly help their child’s education progress by having the resources needed at home without having the expenditure. We are very excited to have this program up and running in September 2022.

Our greatest achievement this year was reestablishing our connection with our school’s fund raising society, Friends of Glenbow (FOG). With both school council and FOG working together we have been able to better serve the staff and students at Glenbow. We have been able to plan events, fill needs and strengthen the connection of the members of our school community. As an example, in May school council, FOG and school staff were able to work together to host an amazing afternoon of cleaning out the Glenbow Community Gardens followed by a BBQ. The event was attended by students, staff, parents and community members of all ages. Those who attended thoroughly enjoyed working and connecting with each other especially after we were not able to connect in that way for so long due to COVID 19 restrictions. As a school council we look forward to continuing working closely with FOG in the next school year.

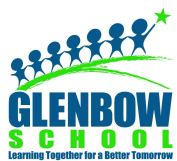
Challenges
